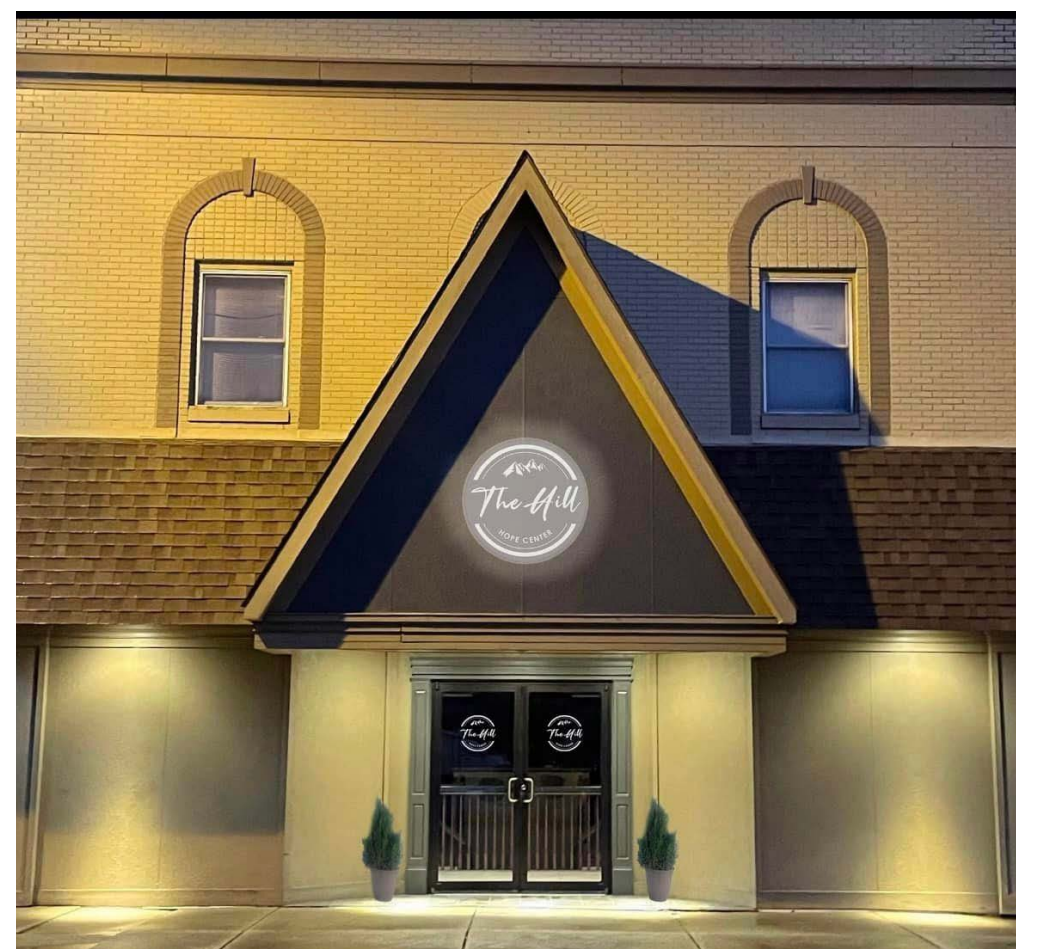


A GRACE MISSIONAL COMMUNITY:

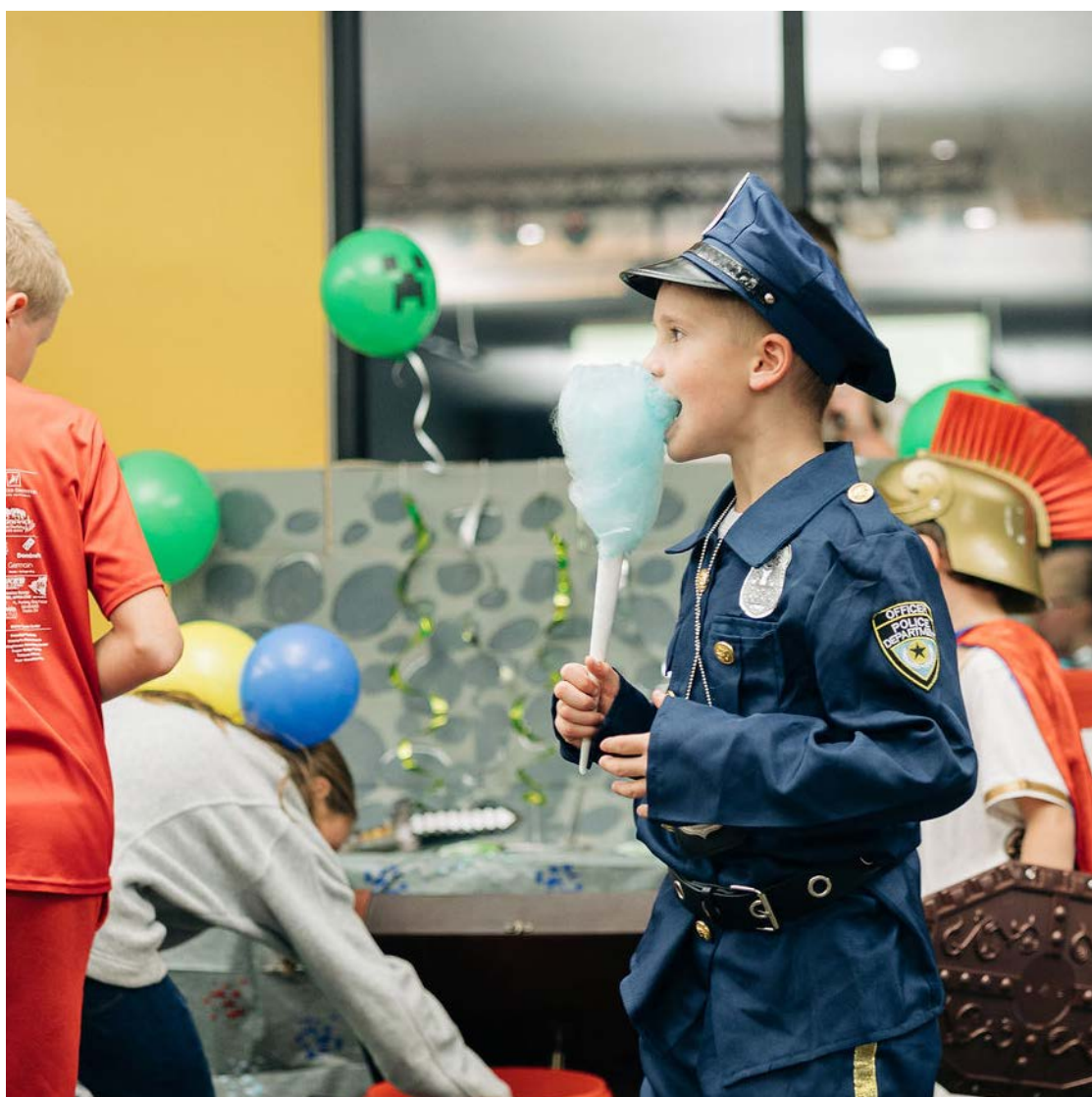

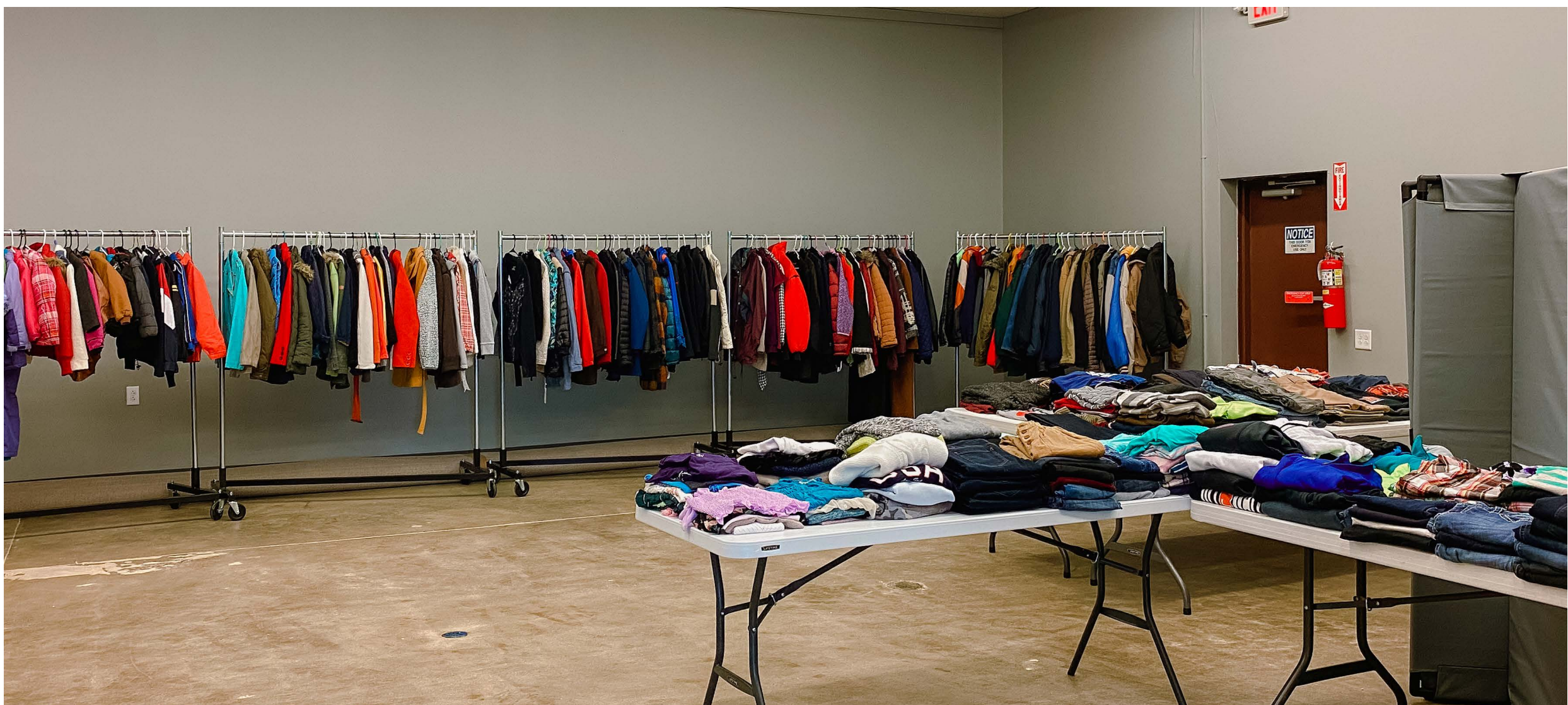
